HORSE DAYS CAMPGROUND RULES

1. No camping unit is to be parked without first stopping at the Campground Office and receiving passes. The office is located in the main campground area. The office will be open from 9am – 10pm on Thursday, August 18th for early arrivals thru Sunday, August 21st. from 9am – 6pm. Other times are available by appointment only. Camping fee will include one (1) sticker to be displayed in the door of the unit and one (1) corresponding vehicle pass for the windshield of the registered vehicle only. Only one (1) vehicle will be allowed in the campground per unit. Pre-paid camping stickers will be issued upon check-in at the campground office. This does include admission passes. Gate entry passes and wristbands may be purchased at the Horse Days Office.
2. Reservations: 100% deposit is required. Reservations for individuals or groups will be dated upon receipt and handled on a first come – first served basis. Anyone wishing to be placed together must send all reservations and fees in one envelop. There must be a separate registration form for each camper. No exceptions will be allowed. After the reserved campsite has been occupied – no refunds will be made. Person purchasing the camping permit will be considered the head of the campsite and will be responsible for camp conduct. No switching, changing or reselling your campsite is permitted. You must be 18 years of age or older to rent a campsite. Party's not meeting camping requirements or refusing to purchase a camping permit will be removed from the fairgrounds.
3. All campers will provide their own water hose, and electrical cord. All water hoses must be attached to a back-flow eliminating device. Dumping of any waste water on the ground is prohibited by order of the Boone County Health Department. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will be assessing fines for violations of campground rules. For this reason, please comply with all rules. Holding tank pumping will be made available at an additional cost starting Saturday. Please notify the Camping Administrator if you wish to use this service. **There is no dump station.**
4. All golf carts not authorized by the Horse Days board must register with Campground Administrator when checking in. A fee of \$25 will be assessed for each golf cart. You must be 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart on the grounds. Failure to adhere to these rules may result in the impounding of the cart.
5. **Pets shall be kept on a leash (no more than 6 feet in length) and ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE THE CAMPGROUND AREA ONLY IN APPROVED AREAS OF THE FAIRGROUNDS.** Exceptions will be made for Seeing-eye dogs and those registered in exhibitions. All dogs must be leashed or tied at the campsite, and must stay on the assigned lot. Health rules prohibit any other pets in the campsites. Campers with dogs must maintain a clean and healthy environment on their site. Droppings and litter must be removed and placed in approved containers. On site animal control has the authority to remove any dangerous, nuisance or un-cared for animals. You must be able to present proof of current license including vaccination at all times. Failure to observe responsibility for your dog could result in a loss of camping privileges.
6. All camping units must face in the same direction, as designated by campground committee. All units must be within their assigned and striped area.
7. Alternate camping areas: The Track infield camping area and the Center camping area which is located just east of the Grand Stands.
8. Rustic camping (no water or electricity) is available for tents and campers. Please contact the Camping Administrator for locations of such sites.
9. It is important that the unit registered is the same size as you bring. If it is different, we will attempt to accommodate the change, but cannot guarantee your original site.
10. Camping area is to be kept clean. Trash containers are available throughout the grounds – please use them.
11. Loud music, disorderly conduct, profanity or other activities that might disrupt the campgrounds will not be tolerated – you will be escorted off the grounds. No refunds will be issued.
12. Campfires are only allowed in burn pits that contain the fire off of the ground. You may not transport or bring firewood into the fairgrounds. Approved wood for burning will be available at the Camp sight office.
